FOR HOME

Drip water on straw wrappers-

Remove wrappers from straws by compressing the wrapper down the length of the straw. Set the wrapper on a table. Place one end of the unwrapped straw in water. Put a fingertip over the open end of the straw to hold water inside. Lift the straw out of the water and hover over the straw wrapper. Remove your fingertip to release a drop of water on the compressed wrapper. Watch as the wrapper expands. SAY: It looked like the wrapper came to life! But did it? (no) Water does give life to humans, animals, and plants, but only for a short time. Living water from Jesus gives life forever.
